
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APPLICABLE MODEL(S)/VINS

2007-2008 MX-5 PRHT vehicles with VINs lower than JM1 NC**** ** 148630 (built before January 11, 2008)

DESCRIPTION

On some vehicles the windshield header and roof panel may rattle while driving. The cause is the latching force between the top lock and striker is not sufficient. As a mass-production change, the latching force has been increased.



Customers having this concern should have their vehicle repaired using the following repair procedure.

REPAIR PROCEDURE

NOTE:


- The following procedure outlines tightening the top lock adjustment nut by one turn.
- 1. Verify customer concern.
- 2. Remove the top lock spring (A) from the pin (C).
- 3. Remove snap ring (B) from pin (C) using snap ring pliers, then remove the pin.

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4. Remove the two screws (D) from the cover (E).

NOTE:


- The screw threads are coated with Loctite, removal may be difficult.
- If the screws are damaged or stripped during removal, replace as necessary.




5. Remove the cover (E) from the top lock (F).

NOTE:

• If the top lock cover is broken, replace as necessary.



6. Turn the adjustment nut (G) clockwise by one complete turn (360°) to increase the latching force.




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7. Reinstall the cover (E) to the top lock and tighten the screws (D).

NOTE:


• Apply Loctite to the screw threads.



- 8. Insert the pin (C) into the top lock.
- 9. Reinstall the snap ring (B) using the snap ring pliers.

NOTE:


- After securing the snap ring, ensure there is no play between the snap ring and pin.
- If the snap ring breaks or is broken, replace as necessary.




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10. Install the top lock spring (A) to the pin (C).



- 11. Check the clearance (A) between the roof panel (1) and windshield header (2).
 - (A) = 4-8mm



12. Verify repair.
