
Revision note: "CAUSE", "MASS PRODUCTION CHANGE", "SUBJECT VIN & PRODUCTION DATE RANGE" and "REPAIR PROCEDURE" have been changed.

Subject: Convertible Top-Inner Cloth Coming Off Causing Poor Appearance and Obstructing View of Back Window

DESCRIPTION

Some vehicles may exhibit a coming off of the inner cloth at the rear end causing poor appearance and obstructing view of the back window.

The coming off occurs when the convertible top is opening and/or closing or by vibration during vehicle driving.



CAUSE

<u>Case A:</u> The <u>J-hook (a)</u> binding to hold the inner cloth becomes loose because of opening/closing the convertible top many times or by heat influence.

<u>Case B:</u> After the previous improvement carried out from January 19, 2016 at the supplier, some of the J-hook has been found that it still becomes loose to bind and hold the inner cloth during the assembly process at the supplier.



MASS PRODUCTION CHANGE

<u>Case A: Clips (Two top-protectors)</u> have been additionally installed to the both side edges of the J-hook to prevent opening/loosening the J-hook.

<u>Case B:</u> An improved inspection process has been started at the supplier, which is to check the appearance of the inner cloth after installation of the clip.

REPAIR PROCEDURE

Choose the suitable repair procedure according to the list in "SUBJECT VIN & PRODUCTION DATE RANGE" Case A or Case B.

Case A: Vehicles NOT having installed the clips (top protectors)

Order the new clips (two top protectors) and cut off the ribs.

Add the glue to the inside of the clips and install them to the both sides of the J-hook according to the following repair procedure "2. Install the clips onto both edges of the J-hook".

NOTE: The clip has a rib. Cut the rib before installation to the J-hook.

Since the rib is an obstacle when installing itself to the inner cloth, cut the rib off, and add the adhesive to inside of the clip to stabilize it to prevent of J-hook sliding to the transverse direction.

Case B: Vehicle already having installed the clips (top protectors)

Newly order the clips and replace the defective clips with a new one according to the following procedure. The old clips being installed before seem to have less fitting force.

NOTE: Cutting the rib is **NOT** needed for Case B vehicles because the J-hook has a groove to install the ribs easily. Also it is not needed to add glue to the clips.

If you receive a customer complaint on this concern, use the following repair procedure.


- 1. Install the inner cloth.
 - 1). Open the soft top to the position shown in the following picture.







2). Install the resin edge of the tension cloth into the J-hook.












Turn over resin edge of tension cloth in this direction.

NOTE: Make sure to turn over the resin edge of the tension cloth to the correct direction as shown.

Cross section










3). Install the edge of the inner cloth into the J-hook.







-Cross sectional view of Tension Cloth and Inner cloth to show how they are installed in J-hook-




4). Lightly pull the inner cloth and verify that the inner cloth does not come off easily.

2. Install the clips onto both edges of the J-hook.


1) Cut off the shaded area of the clip (for both left and right sides).

Apply an appropriate adhesive to the inside of the clip as shown in the illustration.
