#### DESCRIPTION

Some vehicles may experience MIL illuminates while engine is running. DTC P0012 is set into PCM memory. - P0012: CMP Timing Over-Retarded

The PCM logic for CMP (Camshaft Position Sensor) timing detection is incorrect. Customers having this concern should have their vehicle repaired using the following repair procedure.

## REPAIR PROCEDURE

1. Verify customer concern.

#### NOTE:

- Record customer radio station presets before disconnecting negative battery cable.
- 2. Replace PCM with a modified one. Refer to appropriate Workshop Manual section 01-40 PCM REMOVAL / INSTALLATION.
- 3. Verify repair.
