

DESCRIPTION

Some vehicles with 6-speed automatic transmissions there may be what appears to be excessive sealant around the joint between the automatic transmission case and the extension housing. This is most noticed around the lower 2 bolts attaching the extension housing to the transmission case. This sealer has been applied to this area to prevent ATF seepage and is NOT a cause for concern or repair.
